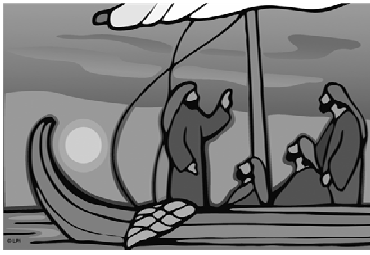

CERTIFICATES OF ELIGIBILITY

We are frequently requested to provide Certificates of Eligibility for people acting as godparents and/or sponsors by the church where the ceremony is being performed. The certificate, which is certifying that the person is a member of our Parish, is a practicing Catholic, and is qualified to act as a Sponsor for the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation or as a Witness for the Sacrament of Matrimony, is a very important document. We can not provide one if we are not absolutely certain that the person meets the qualifications noted above. Since we do not know ever person personally, we use the Parish Registration Data Base to confirm the person is a member of our parish. If you are not in the system, we are unable to give you a Certificate. Thank you for not asking.
